**INTERVENE QUICKLY  
AND RESPECTFULLY**





### **TIP:**

When disruptive behaviors occur, intervene quickly but respectfully, focusing on the behavior rather than the student. Use conflict management techniques to resolve situations.

### **RECOMMENDATION:**

Apply logical and proportional consequences to inappropriate behaviors, and ensure that young people understand the reasons for these consequences.



### **TIP:**

Establish a positive reinforcement system to encourage appropriate behaviors.  
This can include verbal praise, symbolic rewards, or additional privileges.

### **RECOMMENDATION:**

Be specific in your compliments and rewards, clearly indicating which behavior is appreciated and why.



### **TIP:**

Invest time in building strong relationships with each young person by showing interest, actively listening, and offering sincere encouragement.

### **RECOMMENDATION:**

Organize group activities that promote cohesion and allow young people to get to know each other better.

## TIP:



Establish clear rules and expectations from the start of the school year and ensure they are visible in the classroom. Involve the students in creating these rules to encourage their adherence.  
This nurtures their need for control!

## RECOMMENDATION:

Use posters, pictograms, or charts to remind them of the rules/expectations/logical consequences and discuss them regularly with them.

## TIP:



Create daily routines for common activities, such as the start of the day, transitions between activities, and the end of the day. This helps young people know what to expect and feel secure in a structured environment. It nurtures their need for predictability!

## RECOMMENDATION:

Display the routines in the room that you co-constructed with them and repeat them regularly to reinforce their importance.
