# TIPS AND RECOMMENDATIONS





## VARY THE ENERGY AND ALLOW MOVEMENT

Attention does not last indefinitely! Incorporate active breaks, rhythm variations, and allow controlled movement to prevent cognitive overheating and boost concentration.



## **MAKE YOUR EXPECTATIONS EXPLICIT**



Don't expect a "obvious" behavior from a student: teach it as real knowledge. Show, practice, encourage, and correct, just like for a school skill.



## ASSIGN ROTATING ROLES

Actively involve your students by assigning them roles with responsibility (calm guardian, mediator, timekeeper, etc.). This enhances their engagement and sense of belonging.





## **DIFFERENTIATE WITHOUT STIGMATIZING**



Offer diverse support, simplify some instructions, encourage mutual assistance... but within a shared framework accessible to all, so that each student feels included and valued.



## RITUALIZE WITHOUT RIGIDITY

Establish rituals (entry, transitions, closure) to structure the times, but always leave some flexibility to adapt these rituals according to the needs of the day or the group's dynamics.
